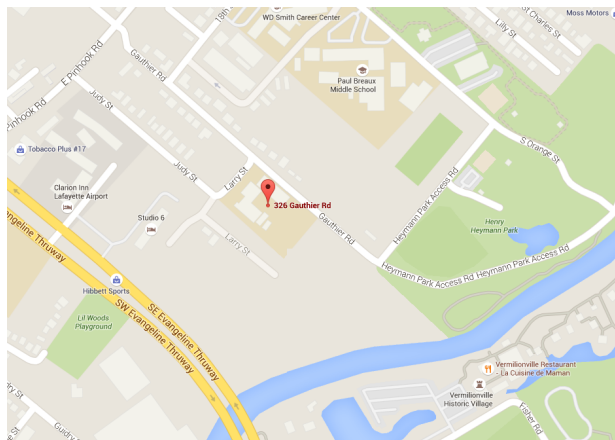

Documentation Needed

Registration Packet provided by Early Childhood with the following: Original Birth Certificate, Original Social Security Card, Current Shot Record, Proof of Residency- current gas, water or electric bill, Proof of Income.

Services for Children with Special Needs

An educational evaluation is offered for children ages 3 through 5 years not enrolled in Kindergarten who may have special needs. Children are serviced in homes, early learning centers and in the school system.
